 2 **road since then.**  
 3 Q You talk about this dog bite, ma'am.  
 4 **A Yes, sir, --**  
 5 Q Did you --  
 6 **A -- on my calf of my left leg.**  
 7 Q Let me -- please let me finish, please. With regard to the  
 8 dog bite, ma'am, did you go to the doctor?  
 9 **A No, I did not.**  
 10 Q Did you draw blood?  
 11 **A No, I did not.**  
 12 Q Did you have a break in your skin?  
 13 **A No. I had a bruise.**  
 14 Q You had a bruise?  
 15 **A Yes, sir.**  
 16 Q This dog you're making reference to, is this a big dog?  
 17 **A No, sir.**  
 18 Q Was a police report filled out?  
 19 **A On the first one, yes. When it bit my dog, I called the**  
 20 **police. Animal Control came down.**  
 21 Q When he -- when he bit your dog?  
 22 **A Yes. He bit my dog twice, not even on Mallard, going up**  
 23 **Blue Star -- Blue Goose Drive.**  
 24 Q Did you take your dog to the vet when --  
 25 **A No, I did not, sir.**

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1 Q In 1999?  
 2 **A Correct.**  
 3 Q Why would it have been brought to your attention after the  
 4 fact, ma'am?  
 5 **A Because it was included as part of a zoning variance hearing**  
 6 **and the township board and the ZBA get a copy of that**  
 7 **packet.**  
 8 Q And this land division application that was submitted --  
 9 MR. THINSCHMIDT: If you would mark that, please.  
 10 (At 11:05 a.m., Plaintiff's Exhibit No. 5 marked  
 11 by court reporter)  
 12 BY MR. THINSCHMIDT:  
 13 Q Are you familiar with that application, ma'am?  
 14 **A I'm familiar with land division applications. I can't say I**  
 15 **have this one memorized.**  
 16 Q Were you familiar with Mr. Dangremond?  
 17 **A Yes, sir.**  
 18 Q And how is it that you were familiar with Mr. Dangremond?  
 19 **A He was the original contact I had when my father was looking**  
 20 **to purchase property on the south side of Mallard.**  
 21 Q And that's the individual who your dad bought the property  
 22 from; is that not true?  
 23 **A Correct.**  
 24 Q And then who is Mr. Saputo?  
 25 **A He was the original purchaser of the lot next to my**

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1 Q Did your dog -- was your dog bleeding as a result of this  
 2 dog bite?  
 3 **A No, sir.**  
 4 Q Was there any permanent -- strike that. Was there any  
 5 puncture wound involved in --  
 6 **A No, sir. Does that mean it didn't happen?**  
 7 Q With regard to the -- in your capacity as the clerk of  
 8 Ganges Township, did you -- have you had any special kind of  
 9 training that you've taken?  
 10 **A A lot of it. For what? You mean elections? Yes. FOIA**  
 11 **policy? I mean what type of training are you asking?**  
 12 Q Okay. What does a Ganges Township clerk do in her  
 13 responsibilities; may I ask that, please?  
 14 **A I'm responsible for accounts payable, payroll, insurance**  
 15 **work, cemeteries, elections, voter registration.**  
 16 Q Do you get engaged in the Land Division Act?  
 17 **A No, sir, I do not. That's zoning. It's zoning and**  
 18 **assessment department.**  
 19 Q Do you get involved in any -- anything with regard to having  
 20 applications submitted for land division?  
 21 **A No, sir.**  
 22 Q Were you at all familiar with the Township of Ganges land  
 23 division application that was submitted by Mr. Saputo -- or,  
 24 strike that, Mr. Dangremond?  
 25 **A It's been brought to my attention after the fact.**

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1 **father's.**  
 2 Q And the lot next to your father's was purchased subsequent  
 3 to your father getting his lot; is that correct?  
 4 **A Correct.**  
 5 Q And in here on this application, if you will, it indicates,  
 6 according to the checkmarks on proposal under C, it says the  
 7 division of parcel -- of the parcel provides access to an  
 8 existing public roadway, and basically it's checked where it  
 9 says each new division has frontage on an existing public  
 10 roadway; is that not true?  
 11 **A That's what it says. I'd say the form is wrong. It should**  
 12 **have been stricken by Mr. Koenes and changed to private, but**  
 13 **it didn't.**  
 14 Q This was never approved, was it, ma'am?  
 15 **A I don't know, sir. I know there was a holdup on the initial**  
 16 **one because they were waiting -- I know there was a tie-up**  
 17 **with the -- when the building permit was issued, blah, blah,**  
 18 **blah, but I know it was eventually resolved. Again, it's**  
 19 **not my area. The township board does not get involved in**  
 20 **land division.**  
 21 Q If it would be approved, they would have signed it or put a  
 22 signature to the document; would they not have, ma'am?  
 23 **A I assume Mr. Koenes would have.**
